Issue Description:

PS-164 Rev7 has been replaced by PS-386 Synthetic Transmission Fluid. Heavy-duty transmission warranties are no longer covered by PS- 164 Rev7 lube. **PS-386 is now mandatory for all warranties effective January 1, 2017.** For a list of a Eaton approved lubricant suppliers, see *Eaton Lubricant Suppliers Guide TCMT0020 EN-US*.

Containment/Corrective Action:

All major OEMs transitioned to the PS-386 approved lubricant in 2016. Approved re-branders should have PS-386 available. Containers of approved lubricants must display the Eaton Approved Lubricant logo for PS-386 as shown below.
